Day 1 Toronto to Mackinac Island

Day 2 Mackinac Island

A full breakfast buffet is included each morning, then we enjoy a locally guided carriage tour of the Island. This afternoon is free for you to enjoy the quaint shops, tour the old fort or simply relax on the Island House's marvelous front porch.
